- Review and correct mistakes on quizzes and tests with your child

Binder

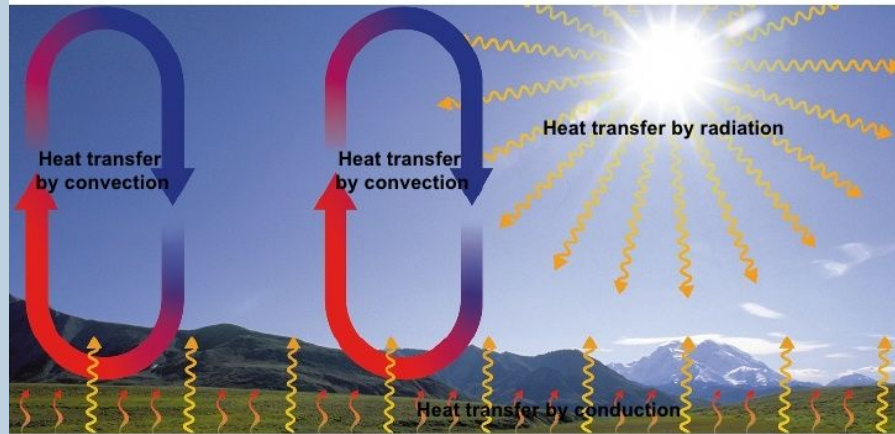
- No Friday Folders- check your child's binder daily for forms coming from the office
